The Niche series of boxes - the 'Trio', 'Diamond' and 'Fourtet' - combine contemporary design, age-old craftsmanship and computer-driven technology, to create a unique collection of beautifully styled and crafted objects. Each box is decorated with original 'limited edition' artwork, laser-etched into its lid.

Forest Visions

The inaugural edition of niche boxes was entitled 'Forest Visions'. With original artwork by Peter Cook, the full set of three designs depicts a stylized view through the Eucalyptus trees atop the scarp in Perth's beautiful Kings Park.



Nouveau Niche

The 2nd edition was entitled 'Nouveau Niche' and is decorated with original artwork by Ian Collishaw. The designs make reference to the 19th century 'Art Nouveau' movement. Inspired by the flowing forms and decorative patterning techniques of Alphonse Mucha, the three designs in the full 'Nouveau Niche' set are drawn from iconic Western Australian plant species.



Transient Tracks

The 3rd edition - released Xmas '08 - is entitled 'Transient Tracks'. The three designs depict stylized Australian animal tracks - the goanna, kangaroo and emu - with infill patterns based on ancient sedimentary rock formations such as the famous Bungle Bungles.



Each Niche box is inset with a silver Scarab maker's mark and is presented in its own beautiful gift-package, with full product information.
